Details of e-mails received from County Councillor Peter Schwier, since the September PC meeting

1. Avian Flu (Bird Flu) outbreak affecting poultry at Tolleshunt Major, near Maldon. 3km Protection Zone set up to avoid the disease spreading geographically and into the human population. Received 7 September.

3. National Power further Consultation on Bramford to Twinstead Re-Inforcement Scheme. New consultation ends 19 October 2022 to consider some changes to the proposals at the western end of the project. Received 15 September.

5. Avian flu – Restrictions now in place in 8 Essex Districts (including Braintree District). The government has declared a Regional Avian Influenza Prevention Zone w.e.f. 12 October in Norfolk, Suffolk and part of Essex. Received 12 October.

7. Micro grants, up to £500, available to support waste reduction projects. Deadline 24 October. Received 13 October.
