- Public consultation on draft Essex Cycling strategy Just a reminder that the public consultation on the draft Essex Cycling Strategy closes on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July. The new draft strategy sets out a vision for cycling in the county, and details the key actions planned to make it a reality. We now want your feedback to help improve it.
- 2. ECC Trading Standards info an end of year infographic showing some of the highlights from the work of the ECC Trading Standards team during 2023-24.
- 3. ECC -Essex Records Office -Heritage Fund to preserve local stories- The <u>Essex</u> <u>Record Office</u> (ERO) will receive £60,000 from The National Lottery Heritage Fund to immortalise local communities.
- 4. **PFCC- Essex Have your say on the Policing, Crime, Fire & Rescue priorities next 4 yrs -** Following his re-election in May, Roger Hirst, Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner for Essex, is now consulting on priorities to be included in his Police and Crime Plan 2024 and his Fire and Rescue Plan 2024. The Fire and Rescue Plan sets the strategic direction and priorities for Essex County Fire and Rescue Service for the next four years.
- 5. ECC adopts new Waste Strategy for Essex A new Waste Strategy for Essex has been adopted by Essex County Council.
- 6. **ECC Remains opposed to pylons proposal. Norwich-Tilbury** Formal response to latest consultation was submitted ahead of last week's deadline. Essex County Council has confirmed it remains in opposition to latest plans to install hundreds of pylons and miles of cables across parts of the county.
- 7. ECC 1,200 additional SEND inclusive summer holiday places across Essex Essex County Council is funding additional summer holiday activity spaces across the county this summer for children and young people with SEND, and their families.
