- 1. Essex residents urged to plan ahead with new Flood grant Mary Long-Dhonau OBE has urged Essex residents to <u>apply for thousands of pounds</u> to better protect their homes after her own experience of surface water flooding.
- 2. Unpaid carers in Essex encouraged to find out more about their rights Carers' Rights Day (21 November) is a national campaign that aims to raise awareness of what rights carers have and signpost to information and guidance.
